description: Secretly Seeking Gay Extramarital Affair



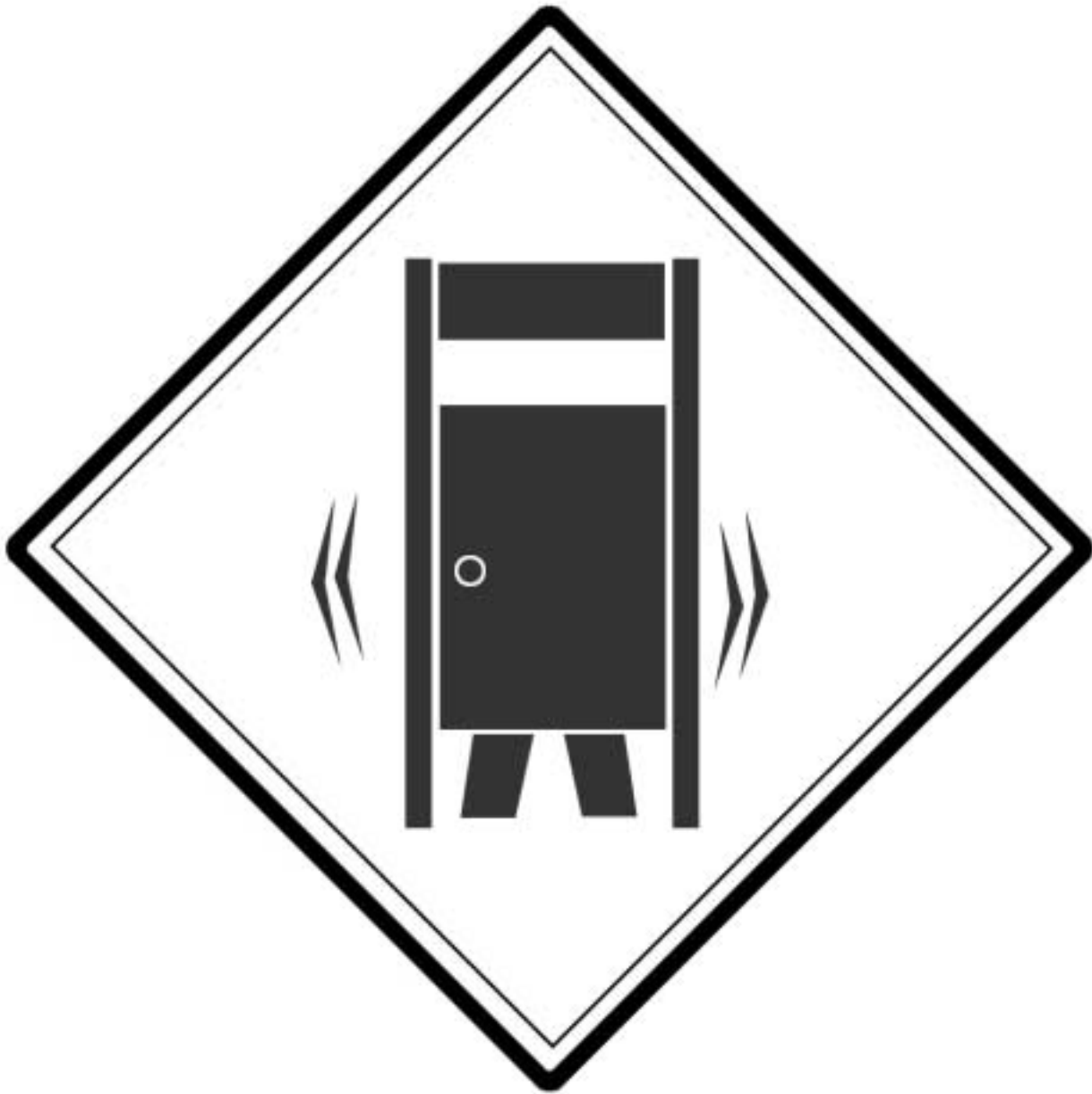
suggested placement: Stick it on your bulletin board when you see that guy who you think might be...
