## INTRODUCTION:

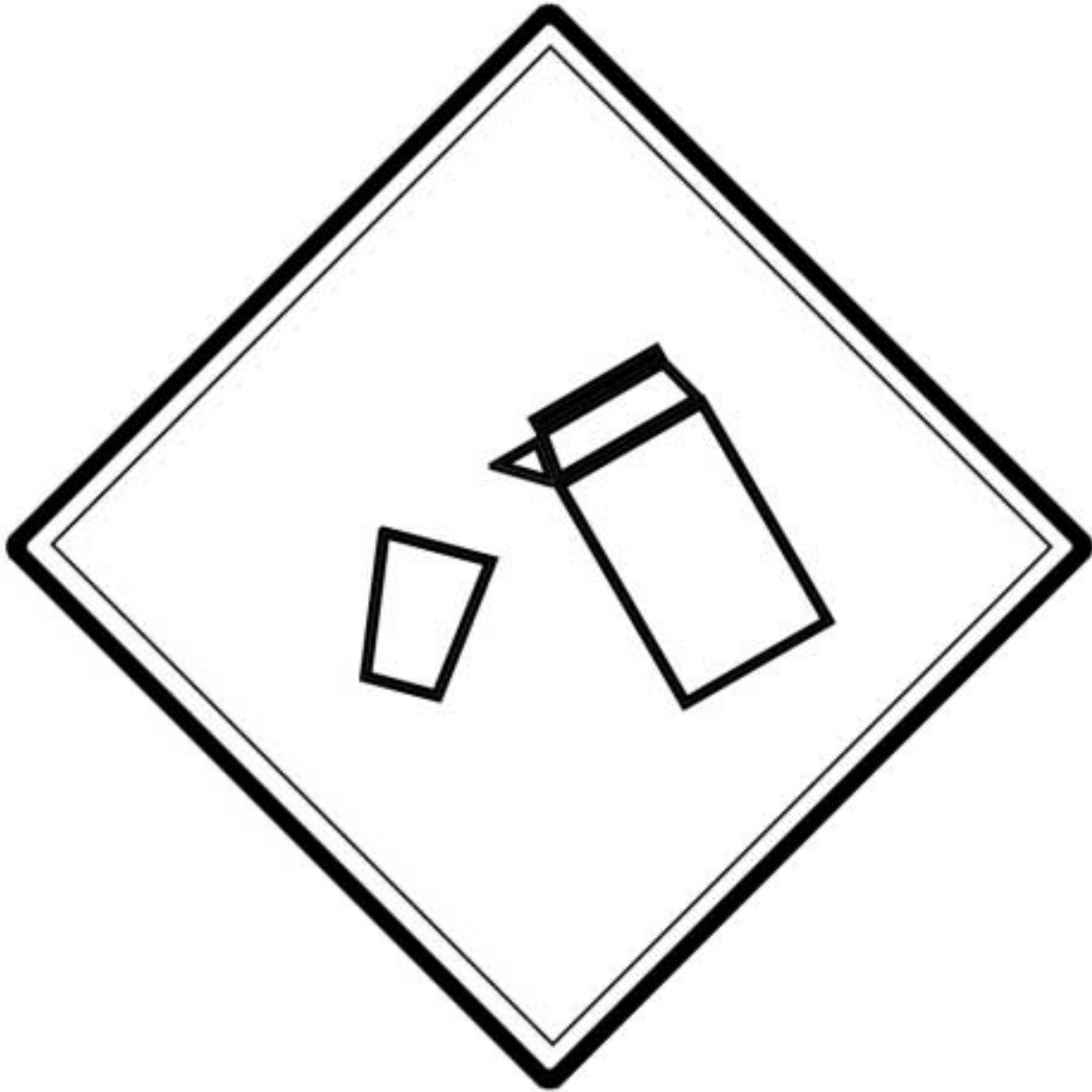

**description: Don't Come In, I'm Masturbating**



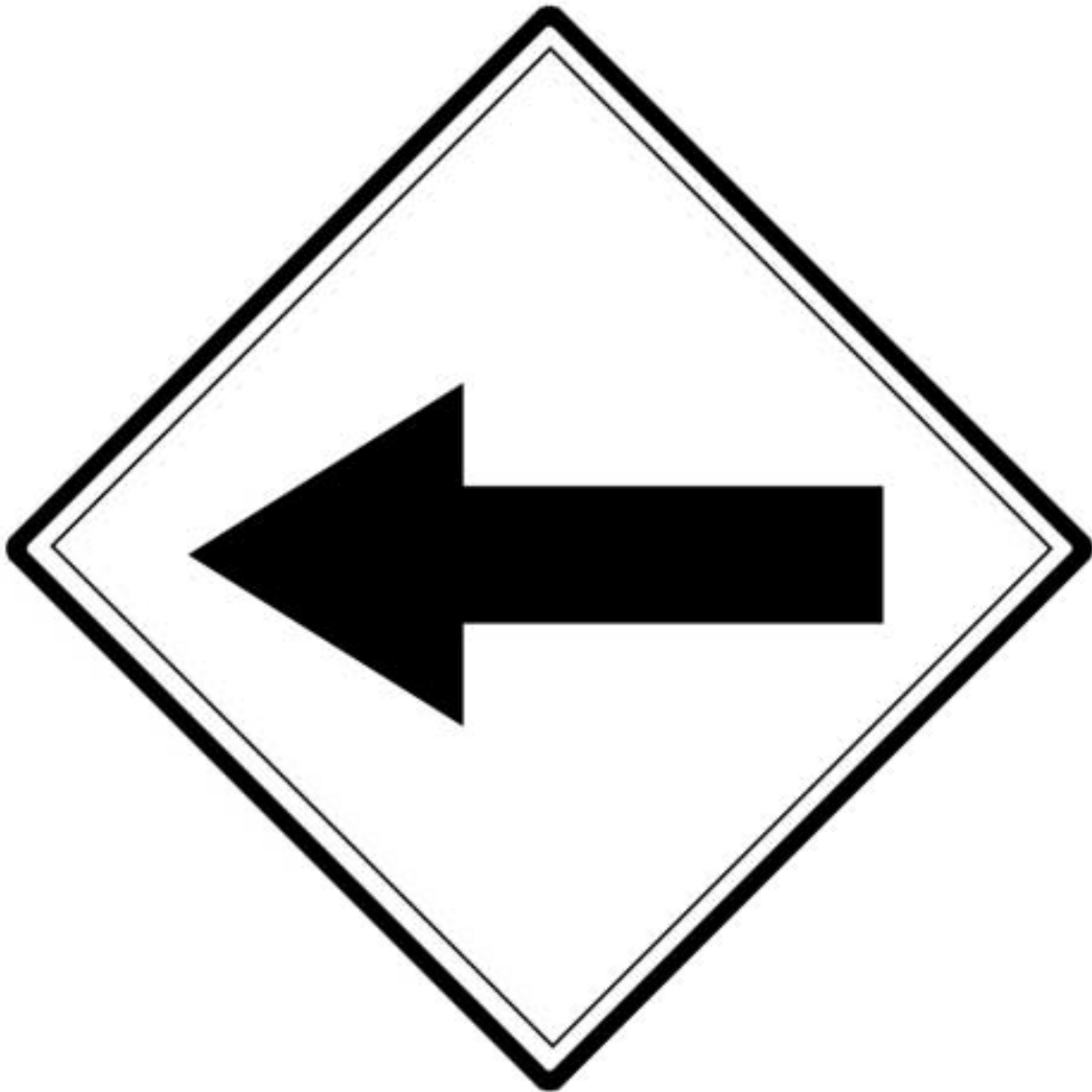
**suggested placement: outside the boy's room**
